

Wembley Downs Soccer Club Volunteer, Coach, and Manager Code of Conduct

As a volunteer, coach, or manager at Wembley Downs Soccer Club, I will:

- 1. **Prioritise Enjoyment**. Remember that players participate for pleasure, and winning is only part of the enjoyment.
- 2. **Encourage Positively**. Never ridicule or yell at a player for making mistakes or losing.
- 3. Be Reasonable. Make fair demands on players' time, energy, and enthusiasm.
- 4. **Uphold the Rules**. Operate within the rules and spirit of the game, including Football West competition rules, and teach players to do the same.
- 5. **Create Positive Experiences**. Ensure that time spent with the team is positive for all players, giving equal attention and opportunities.
- 6. **Ensure Fair Distribution of Playing Time**. Avoid giving excessive playing time to more talented players; strive to provide all players with equal opportunities based on their commitment and participation.
- 7. **Ensure Safety**. Check that equipment and facilities meet safety standards and are appropriate for players' age and ability.
- 8. **Display Professionalism**. Show control, respect, and professionalism to everyone involved in the sport, including opponents, officials, parents, and spectators.
- 9. **Prioritize Player Health**. Show concern for sick or injured players, following medical advice for their return to play.
- 10. **Continually Improve**. Obtain appropriate qualifications and stay updated with the latest coaching practices and youth development principles.
- 11. **Be Organised**. Plan and execute varied, flowing training sessions.
- 12. **Respect Boundaries**. Ensure any physical contact with players is appropriate and necessary for skill development. Ask for consent before any physical contact.
- 13. **Respect Diversity**. Treat every young person with dignity and respect, regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background, or religion.
- 14. **Comply with Policies and Regulations**. Provide a current Working with Children Check when required to interact with minors.
- 15. **Verify Eligibility**. Confirm player identification and eligibility for competitions on behalf of the club.
- 16. **Lead by Example**. Encourage players to display good sportsmanship and respect towards all participants.
- 17. **Communicate Effectively**. Maintain open and respectful communication with players, parents, and club officials.
- 18. **Promote Fair Play**. Teach and demonstrate the importance of playing fairly and respecting opponents.



- 19. **Support Club Values**. Uphold and promote the values and reputation of Wembley Downs Soccer Club.
- 20. **Foster Team Spirit**. Encourage camaraderie and supportive relationships among team members.
- 21. **Prioritise Personal & Professional Growth**. Demonstrate or willingness to pursue a deeper knowledge of the game by obtaining/holding a Foundation of Football, A, B or C accreditation.

I understand that following the Code of Conduct is a requirement of my membership. The Club is committed to working with its members to ensure compliance and will take any necessary actions to protect and support our community-focused environment.

By adhering to these principles, I contribute to creating a positive, safe, and enjoyable environment for all members of Wembley Downs Soccer Club.
